CI Mentorship Programme

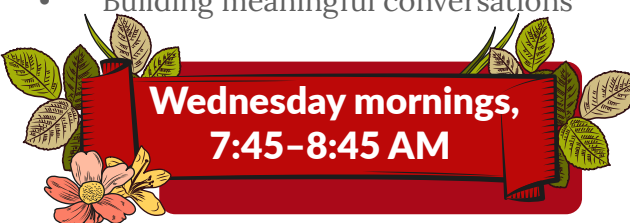
Parents as Partners
